Special purpose adhesive spray designed for use in the upholstery, bedding and furniture industries. The unique webbing spray pattern gives an instant grab while remaining repositionable. Once dry, the foam is bonded to the other surface. Provides a much greater tack than mist adhesive sprays. Dri-Web will not stain or soak through fabrics.

DIRECTIONS: Shake can well before using. Hold can 6 to 8 inches from surface. Use a sweeping motion when spraying. Apply a light to moderate coat to both sides of materials to be bonded. To avoid clogging, after using, turn can upside down and spray against a piece of paper until a clean stream of air flows. If clogging occurs, depress button several time until uniform spray pattern appears.
