## ALBACHEM DRI-WEB PALLET ADHESIVE

### WEB SPRAY PATTERN

Item No. 1175 – Net Wt. 11.75 oz. (333gr) – MADE IN U.S.A.

Special purpose adhesive spray designed for tacking textiles to the pallet during screen printing. The unique webbing spray pattern dries quickly providing a long-lasting tack that will not transfer onto the screen printed garment. Unlike mist adhesive sprays, Dri-Web will not lose its tack when printing on fleece or other materials that may leave a coating over the adhesive. Dri-Web will not stain or soak through fabrics.

**DIRECTIONS:** Shake can well before using. Use on clean dry pallets for best results. Hold can 6 to 8 inches for surface to be sprayed. Use a sweeping motion when spraying. Apply a light coating to entire pallet. To avoid clogging, after using, turn can upside down and spray against a piece of paper until a clean stream of air flows. If clogging occurs, depress button several times until uniform spray pattern appears.
